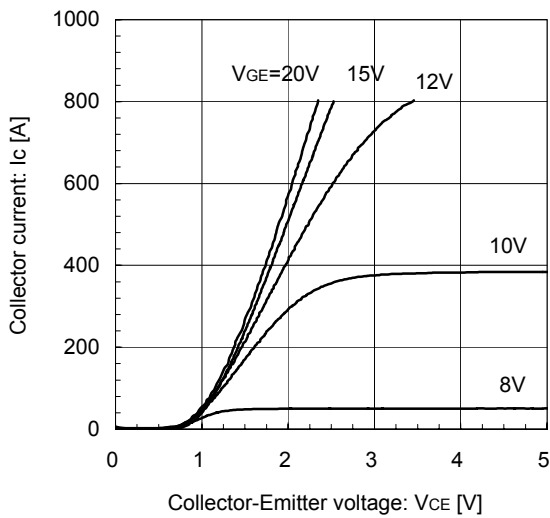

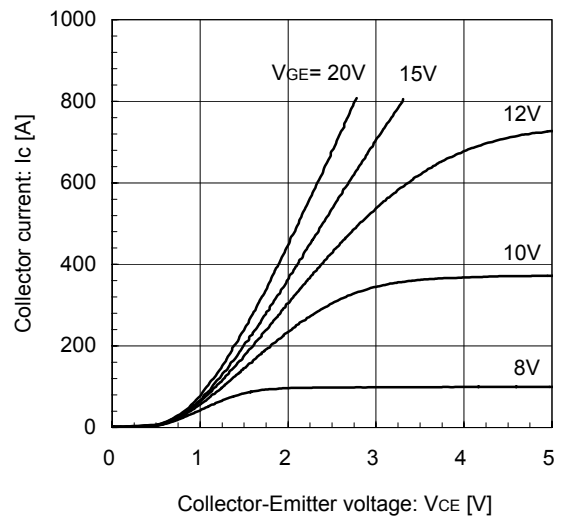

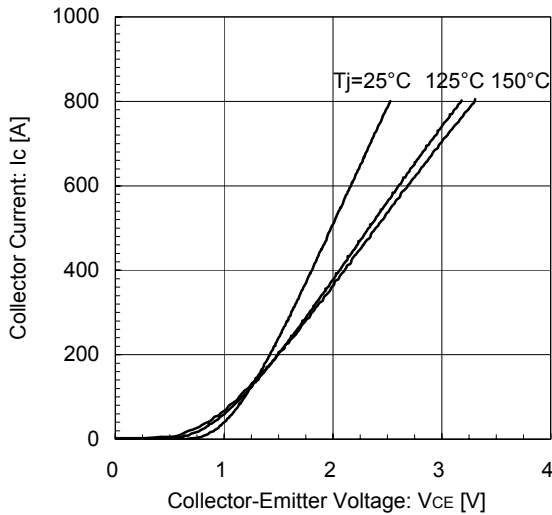
Collector current vs. Collector-Emittor voltage (typ.)
Tj= 25°C / chip



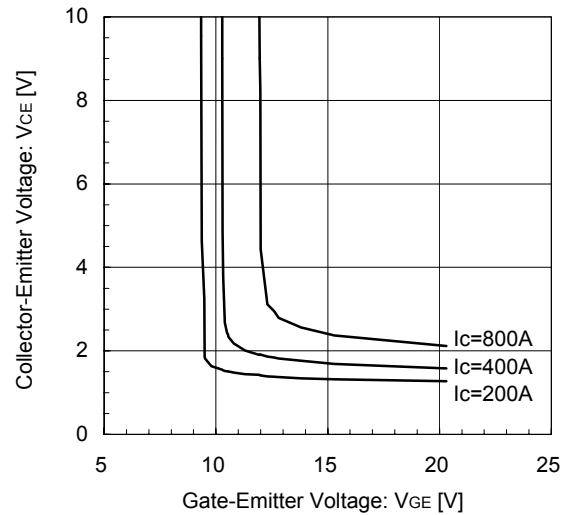
Collector current vs. Collector-Emittor voltage (typ.)
Tj= 150°C / chip



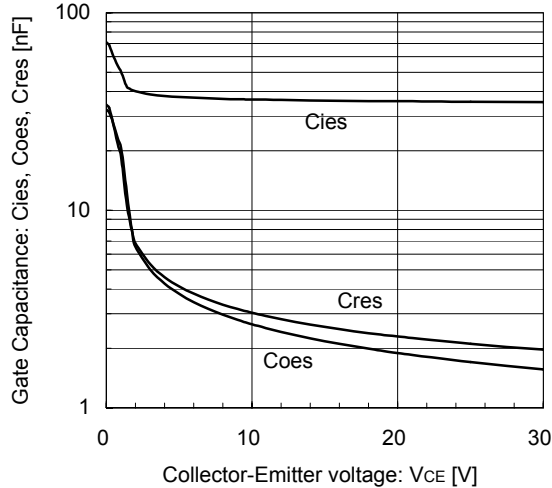
Collector current vs. Collector-Emittor voltage (typ.)
VGE= 15V / chip



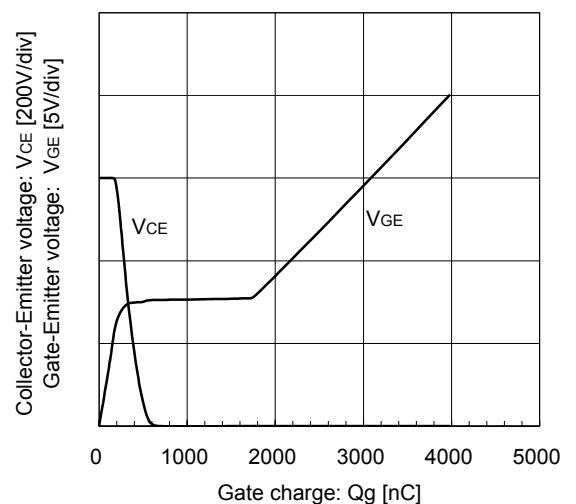
Collector-Emittor voltage vs. Gate-Emittor voltage
Tj= 25°C / chip



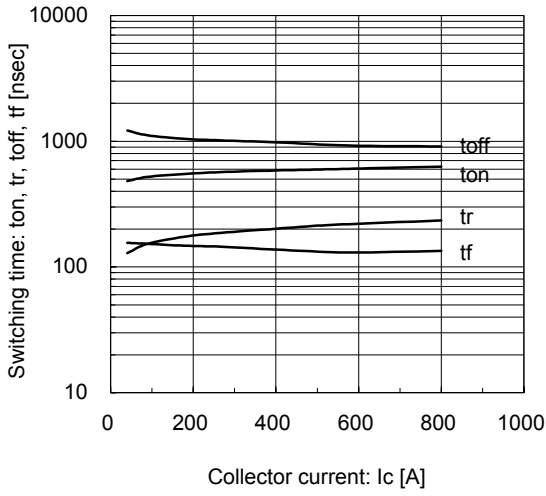
Gate Capacitance vs. Collector-Emittor Voltage
VGE= 0V, f= 1MHz, Tj= 25°C



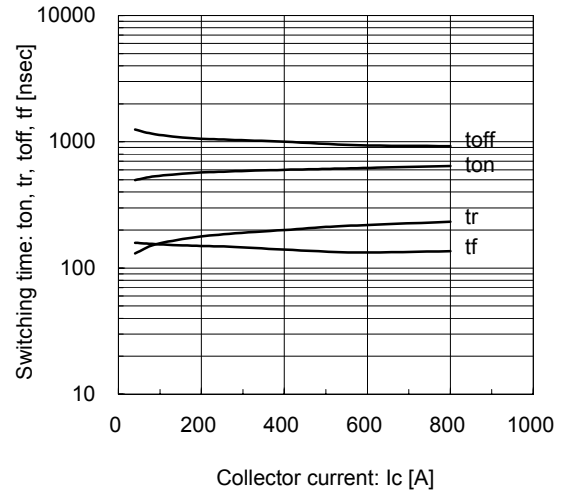
Dynamic Gate Charge (typ.)
Vcc=600V, Ic=400A, Tj= 25°C



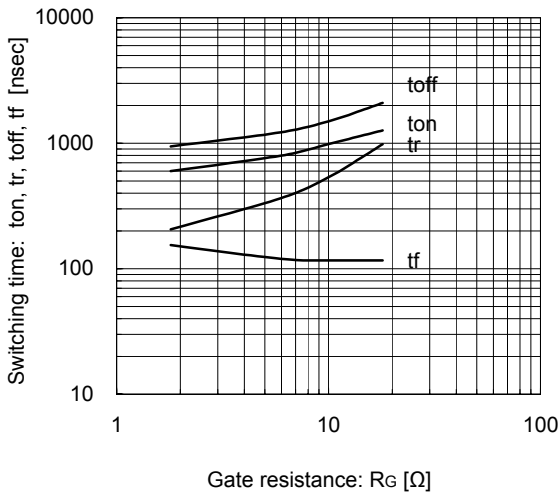
Switching time vs. Collector current (typ.)

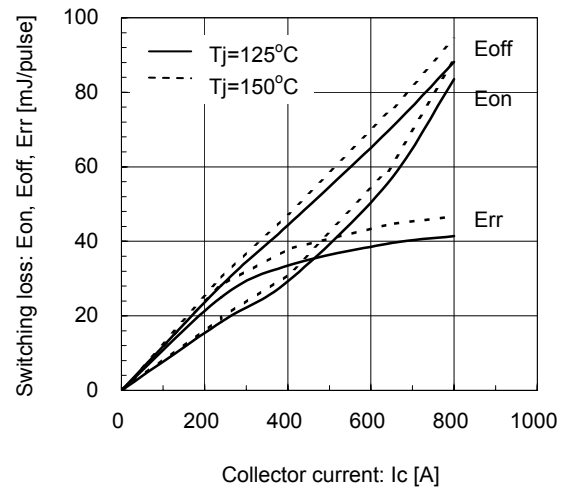
Switching time vs. Collector current (typ.)

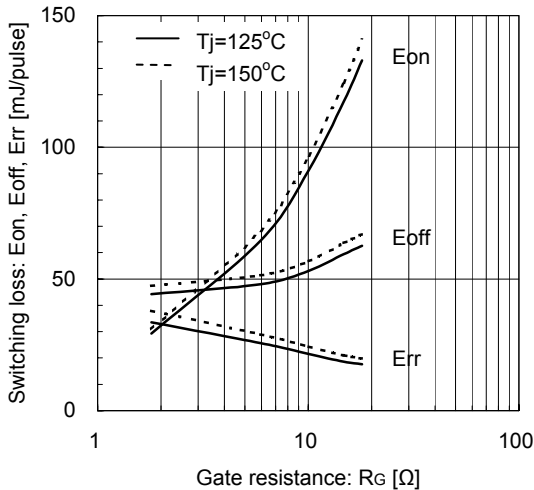
Switching time vs. Gate resistance (typ.)

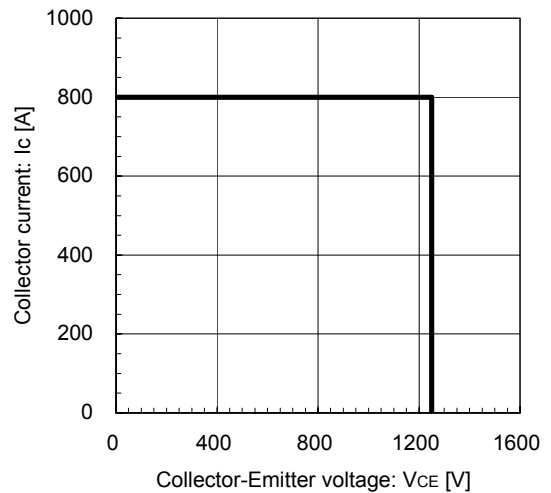
Switching loss vs. Collector current (typ.)
 $V_{CC}=600V, V_{GE}=\pm 15V, R_G=1.8\Omega, T_j=125^\circ C, 150^\circ C$



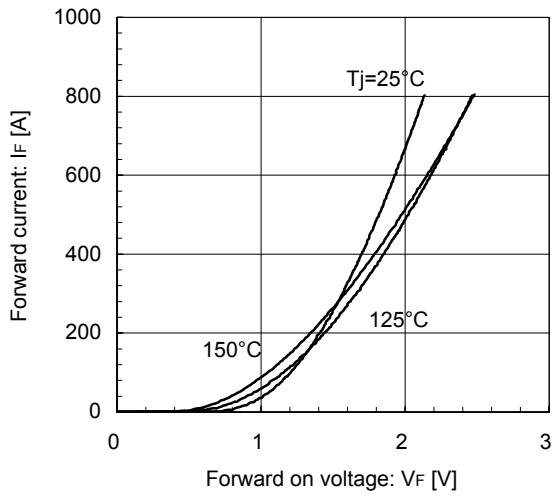
Switching loss vs. Gate resistance (typ.)

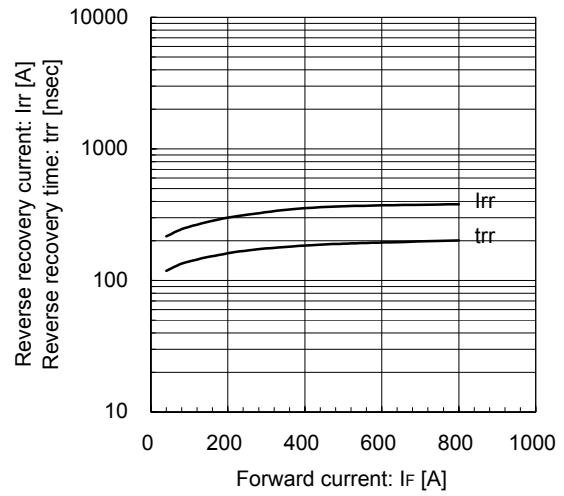
Reverse bias safe operating area (max.)

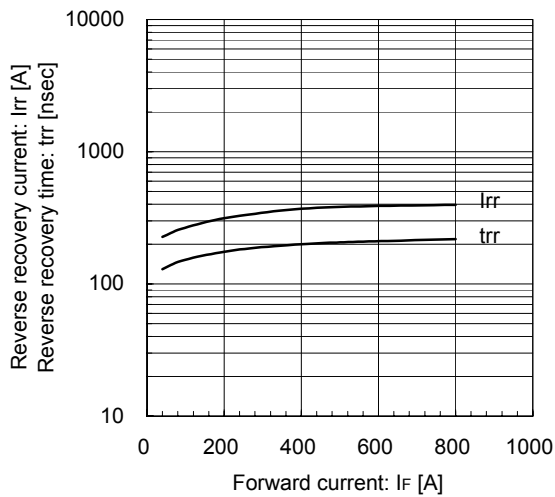
Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage (typ.)

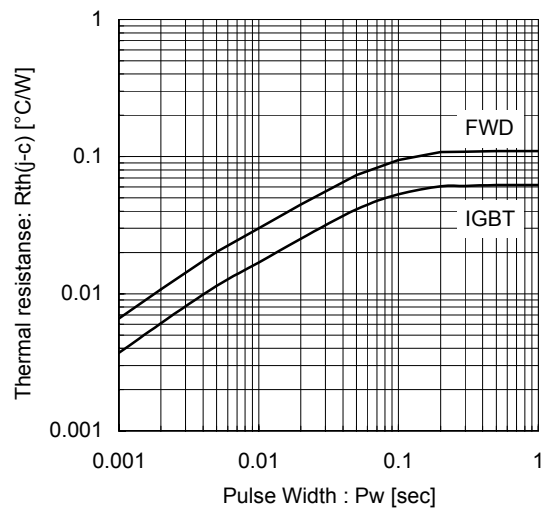
Reverse Recovery Characteristics (typ.)
V_{CC}=600V, V_{GE}=±15V, R_G=1.8Ω, T_j=125°C



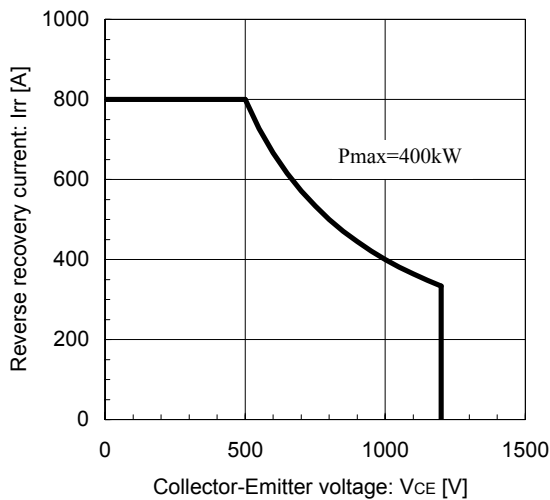
Reverse Recovery Characteristics (typ.)
V_{CC}=600V, V_{GE}=±15V, R_G=1.8Ω, T_j=150°C



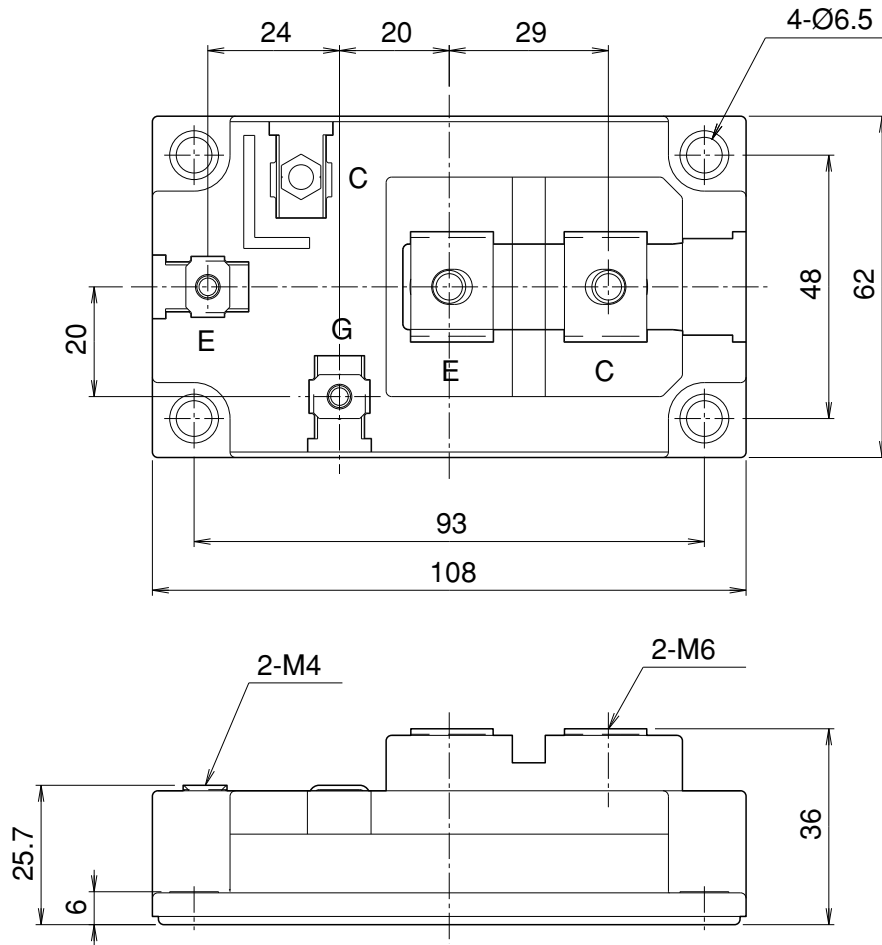
Transient Thermal Resistance (max.)



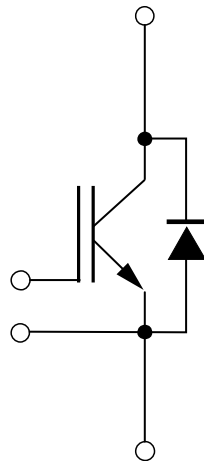
FWD safe operating area (max.)
